

Plasterboard Skip Info

Advice on loading the Skip

- Heavy metal on the bottom
- Large wood/plastic pieces next
- Bagged material on top
- Do not raise the sides of the skip —keep it a level load
- Unsure give us a call

What this includes:

- This is for Plasterboard only

Tips— These are chargeable extras

- Foam Backing must be removed
- Cement
- Wood
- Polystyrene or insulation
- No tiles attached to the plasterboard

Accessibility for lorry and skip:

No matter which size skip you choose, they will arrive on the same size lorry. It will require a clearance of 9ft width & 12ft height. Please take into consideration overhead cables and overhanging trees.

What not to put in:

- * Asbestos (can supply dedicated skip for this)
- * Food Waste
- * Hazardous Waste
- * Gas Cylinders
- * Liquids/solvents

If any of the above are found in your skip you will be contacted, and extra charges may apply.

METAL REBATES
